Facility and Water Sports Acceptance of Responsibility and Liability

The below named individual, being identified as a responsible adult of the sponsoring named group using the facility, accepts the following rules and guidelines and is charged with their enforcement.

GENERAL FACILITY LIABILITY RELEASE:

The below named sponsoring group using the facility hereby releases the Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center of Tampa, Florida and it's agents and employees (both paid and volunteer staff) from liability in case of accident or injury to a guest/participant. WATER SPORTS LIABILITY RELEASE:

NO LIFEGUARD IS PROVIDED FOR WATER SPORT ACTIVITIES; SWIMMING OR BOATING IS AT OWN RISK.

- 1. You must schedule use of the swimming pool and lake with the Conference Center Office prior to use.
- 2. Red Cross Certified Lifeguard is suggested. One lifeguard or RESPONSIBLE ADULT per 30 children/youth.
- 3. All swimming and boating hours shall be during daylight hours.
- 4. All children/youth under the age of 18 shall be accompanied by an adult, parent or counselor.
- 5. In addition to the lifeguard or RESPONSIBLE ADULT, one qualified adult swimmer shall be designated as "Pool, Lake or Boat Watch" with the express responsibility of swimmer and boater safety and rules compliance.
- 6. Ensure that all swimmers and boaters are thoroughly briefed, understand, and comply with established pool/lake rules.
- 7. Basic cleanliness and order shall be maintained. All equipment or building discrepancies should be reported immediately to the main office.
- 8. Emergency medical or law enforcement services are initiated by dialing 911. Tell the operator that you are at the Tampa Bay Baptist Conference Center at 15601 Lake Magdalene Blvd. and someone will meet the responding agents at the front gate. Inform the main office immediately AFTER making a 911 call so we can coordinate with responding agencies.
